In this session, counsel and quantum experts will provide an introduction to accounting documents (balance sheet, income and cash flow statements) and information (book v. market value, accounting income v. cash flow), then discussing potential causes for non-comparability (non-GAAP/non-IFRS, GAAP V. IFRS, inconsistent estimates, and internal accounting inconsistencies). A critical query will explore purposes accounting data is useful (multiples, sunk cost/NCC approaches), with key examples and a look to the future.
